Dorian Komanoff Bandy, College Scholar and music major in the College of Arts and Sciences, will receive the Cornell Undergraduate Artist Award for excellence in the arts, and present **LES PETITS VIOLONS PLAYS HAYDN**, a performance by the baroque orchestra Les Petits Violons and special guest soloists. The celebration will commemorate Haydn's bicentennial year with music from the composer's early and middle periods.

The performance will feature symphonies, a keyboard concerto, and sorbet courses of vocal works and arias performed by Cornell's Zachary Wadsworth and Sarah Robinson. With American baroque musicians Elizabeth Field and Stephanie Vial, and Italian fortepianist Stefania Neonato.

Bandy, baroque violinist, violist, early keyboardist and conductor, will direct the concert from harpsichord.

The Cornell University Undergraduate Artist Award will be presented to Bandy by Council for the Arts Interim Director Judith Kellock, Professor of Music, Neal Zaslaw, and Department of Music Chair, Roberto Sierra.

In conjunction with the CORNELL EISSNER ARTIST OF THE YEAR AWARD, the Council for the Arts (CCA) awards an annual citation to an undergraduate student in the arts – the Cornell University Undergraduate Artist Award. The CCA selects from within the university an outstanding undergraduate student who has demonstrated notable achievements in one or more artistic disciplines and excellence and exceptional activity in the arts. The student recipient receives a monetary award, and presents his / her work.

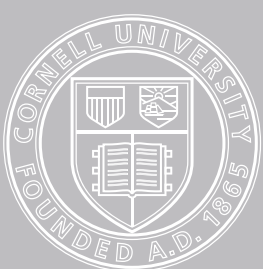
